Chapter NSDAR and the King's
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Ancell Cemetery – Turn E on Rt PP at Kelso; cross viaduct over I-55. Cem is about 2 ½ mi from Kelso in Commerce Twp.

Bell Cemetery – no longer exists

Brennecke Cemetery – Located on Hwy 61 in Kelso at 1st St, N of Dogwood Dr. Cem is 1 block N, near end of St in a field.

Bugg Cemetery – Go W on Hwy 91 for 2 ½ mi from Hwy 61 at Morley. Turn S on a rural road for 11.6 mi to Vanduser substation. The cem is in a field ¼ mi S of substation.

Cason Cemetery – Go S of Benton on Hwy 77, turn R at Co Rd D and go 4/10 mi then turn on a gravel rd and go S for 1 mi. The cem is about ½ mi off the rd on the L in the woods.

City Cemetery – Located in Sikeston on S Kinghighway about 2 blocks S of Malone St.

Cobb Cemetery – From the jct of Malone and N. Main, go N to Kennedy Dr then R and proceed to N Ingram Rd. Turn L and go N 1 ½ mi. Cem is back of an orchard in a field about ¼ mi from N Ingram Rd.

Commerce Cemetery - (African American) – Located in a wooded area at the NW corner where County Rds E and N jct W of Commerce.

Dennis (Montgomery) Cemetery
Located on privately owned land to which there is no access. Take Hwy 77 about 2 mi N of Oran. Can be seen from the Hwy.

Dunn Cemetery – Turn L at the jct of Hwy 61 and 77 going to Oran. Cem is 8/10 mi from the jct on the R past Forest Hills Cemetery.

Forrest Hills Cemetery – Located N of Morley at the jct of Hwy 61 and 77 as it makes a “Y”.

Friend Cemetery – Located in Sikeston at the jct of Hwy 77 and W.

Garden of Memories Cemetery – Located on W Murray Lane in Sikeston.

Hunter Cemetery I – Located by the Presbyterian Church on the corner of Wakefield and Allen Blvd in Sikeston.

Hunter Cemetery II – Go N on Hwy 61 out of Sikeston to the 1st private road on the S, S of Scott County Central School.

Jones Cemetery – Located on Albert Scherer farm on Rt. PP.

Lambert Cemetery – Located in the village of Lambert at the E edge of Benton.

McMullin Cemetery – Go N for 2 3/10 mi on Rt 77 N of Diehlstadt, then

turn R on gravel rd and continue for ½ mi, turn R and go an additional ½ mi.

Memorial Park Cemetery – Located in Sikeston at the end of S Kingshighway.

Mennonite Graves – Go N from Sikeston on Hwy 61 to Rt ZZ, then go L for about 1/8 mi E of Tanner Community. Graves are in a field about ½ mi S on the Herman Newman farm.

Miner Baptist Cemetery – Located at Miner.

Moore Cemetery – At the jct of Hwy 77 and Rd W turn R and go 9/10 mi. Cem is in a field. No access by car.

New Morley Cemetery – Take Hwy 61 from Sikeston to jct of Hwy 91, turn R. Cem is about 4/10 mi.

Oakdale Cemetery – Located on Co Rd R, 6 mi E of Benton and 2 mi E of Commerce.

Plainview (Perkins) Cemetery – Located on a hill overlooking Perkins, 7 mi W of Oran on Hwy W turn R on Hwy P for about 7/10 mi to Missionary Baptist Church.

Pleasant Valley Cemetery – From Sikeston go E on Old Hwy 62 to the 1st through blacktop rd E of I-55, turn L and go N for 3.4 mi. Path to the cem is on the right.

Pollard Cemetery – Go E of Benton, 4½ mi on Hwy 77, turn L for 1/10 mi on gravel rd, turn at 1st R on Co Rd and go about 8/10 mi.

Prince Cemetery – From Commerce, go E along the rd which follows Powers Island Cut. The cem is about ½ mile down the rd on the right.

Rockview Cemetery – Near Rockview about 7/10 mile from Hwy M.

St. Ambrose Cemetery – Located at Chaffee on Hwy A.

St. Denis Cemetery – Located behind the Catholic Church in Benton.

Smith West End Cemetery - (African American) – Located in Sikeston off W Malone.

Sunset of Memory Cemetery (African American) – Located in Sikeston on Alabama St.

Thomas Cemetery – A private cem on a hill overlooking Perkins.

Union Park Cemetery – Located on Hwy A just E of Chaffee.

Unity Cemetery – Located 4 ½ mi E of Benton on Hwy 77 and 2 9/10 mi from I-55.

Vanduser Cemetery – Go W from Crowder on gravel Rd to the Rd that turns N immediately E of a little river. Go N about 1 mi, the cem is destroyed except for 1 stone.

Warfield Cemetery – Go N from Sikeston on Hwy 61, turn L on Hwy 91 at Morley. Go to CC, turn L and then go N for 1 9/10 mi.

Watkins Cemetery – Go 12 mi N of Sikeston on Hwy 61 for about 8/10 mi N of the jct of Hwy 77, turn L on unimproved rd for ¼ mi.

Williams Cemetery – At Perkins go 7 mi W of Oran on Hwy W turn R on Hwy P and go 7/10 mi to Missionary Baptist Church.

Wilson Family Cemetery – Located 2 mi E of Grant City on Co Rd 450, on the S side of rd in edge of field.

Wylie Cemetery¹ – Located S of Chaffee on Hwy 77, then go E 0.8 mi on Co Rd 229. Cem on top of hill.
